Delegate Joining Instructions

We look forward to welcoming you to the University of Exeter. We have pleasure in enclosing travel, accommodation and registration details and would ask that you read this carefully.

Transport and Parking

Delegates travelling by Road

Exeter is easily reached by the M5 Motorway to the east and by the A30 to the west.

The University of Exeter Streatham Campus is approximately 30 minutes from the M5.

From the M5 Southbound

Leave the M5 at Junction 29, signed Exeter Airport.

- At the traffic lights at the end of the motorway off slip road, turn right onto the B3015, signed City Centre, and at the first roundabout turn right, signed Exeter Business Park.
- Go straight over at the next two roundabouts, signed Pinhoe, and join the Monkerton Link Road. At the traffic lights bear left onto the B3212, signed City Centre. Take the right-hand lane and at the second set of traffic lights turn right, signed University.
- Pass under the railway bridge (Polsloe Bridge), drive up the hill and at the fourth set of traffic lights turn right onto Mount Pleasant Road, signed University. (Henry's Bar is on the corner of this junction.)
- At the first roundabout take the second exit onto Union Road. Go straight over at the first set of traffic lights onto Prince of Wales Road. After a set of pedestrian crossing traffic lights the road curves to the left and the **University's Stocker Road entrance** is on your right. Use this entrance for the main car parks and the Peter Chalk building.
- Continue along Prince of Wales Road and the **University's Streatham Drive entrance** is on your right. Use this entrance for Holland Hall (see the [Streatham Campus map](#)).

From the East via A303/A30

- After the junction with the M5 (J29) follow the signs for Exeter Business Park. The route then follows the directions given under 'From the M5'.

From the West via the A30

If you are unfamiliar with Exeter or are travelling at peak times, when this route can be congested, we recommend that you join the M5 and follow the instructions from Junction 29.

- Alternatively, leave the A30 at the Dawlish and Marsh Barton turning. Turn left at the large roundabout into Alphington Spur (A377), which becomes Alphington Road. Continue on this road until the large Exe Bridges roundabout; Riverside Leisure Centre is on your left.
- Take the third exit (Bonhay Road), signed Exeter St David's station. After passing the station on your left, turn sharp right at a double roundabout onto St David's Hill.
- Turn left at the first mini roundabout and then left at the next set of traffic lights into New North Road. Take the second right into Streatham Drive and the **University's Streatham Drive entrance** is on your left. Use this entrance for Holland Hall and Peter Chalk Centre (see the [Streatham Campus map](#)).
- For the **University's Stocker Road entrance** bear right along Prince of Wales Road. As the road curves to the right the entrance is on your left. Use this entrance for the main car parks, (see the [Streatham Campus map](#)).

Parking

Residential delegates staying at Holland Hall will be issued a Residential Car Parking Permit on key collection. Please display this clearly in your vehicle with your car registration marked on it. You may park your car at the car park near to your accommodation or you may move your car around campus parking it in any of the campus car parks.

Day Delegates must purchase a car parking ticket from the machines located near to the car parks on campus. The charges during weekdays are:

1 hour	- 60p
2 hours	- £1.00
4 hours	- £2.00
Over 4 hours	- £3.00

There are no parking charges at weekends.

Delegates Travelling by Train

The railway station closest to the University Campus is Exeter St. David's. This is served by main line routes. Once at St. David's you may take a taxi from the rank outside the station, this should cost you no more than £4.00.

If you would like to walk from the station to the campus there is a quick and direct route although it is quite steep.

Leave the station via the main booking hall, and walk across the forecourt keeping to the right of the car parking area. You will meet Bonhay Road. Cross over at the zebra crossing. Turn left, and almost immediately right into a passageway called St. Clement's Lane. Follow this up the hill; it comes out on to St. David's Hill. Cross over and continue up the road opposite (Howell Road). You will then meet New North Road. Cross over at the zebra crossing, and turn left. The next major turning on the right is Streatham Drive. Take this, and fork left after a short distance (still called Streatham Drive). You will see a large map of the campus.

Delegates travelling by Coach/Bus

National Express coaches (telephone 08705 808080) call at Exeter Bus Station.

The main bus station is in the City Centre on Paris Street, about 1 mile from the Streatham Campus and ½ a mile from St Luke's Campus. A local bus service around the city is run by Stagecoach. The 'D' bus service runs from the city centre to St Luke's and the Streatham Campus every 30 minutes during the day Monday – Saturday. Further information is available from www.stagecoachbus.com

Delegates Travelling By Air

Direct flights operate into Exeter International Airport from across the UK and Europe. Exeter Airport is situated six miles from the city centre and transport from the airport to the University Campus may be either by bus or by a short taxi journey. Registration

Delegates arriving on Sunday 14th September may register in Holland Hall coffee lounge between 17:00 hrs and 19:00 hrs.

On Monday 15th September registration will be in Peter Chalk Centre from 8:00 am to 9:00 am. If you arrive later than 9 am, please report to the reception desk in the Peter Chalk Centre.

Day delegates on Tuesday 16th and Wednesday 17th can register from 8:00 am to 9:00 am.

Residential Accommodation at Holland Hall

Check In

On the Day of your arrival you may check in for your accommodation from 3pm onwards. The reception will be open until 10.30pm on all nights of the conference.

After this time the Campus security team will hold the keys.

If you arrive after 10.30pm please make your way to Campus Security, located at Northcote House and contactable. If you travel by taxi, keep your taxi. Once you have received your keys please go to your accommodation block, see map for location.

Advance notification if arrivals after 10.30pm must be made to the Exeter Sales Office, during office hours, on 01392 215566.
